



Family Reunion Update

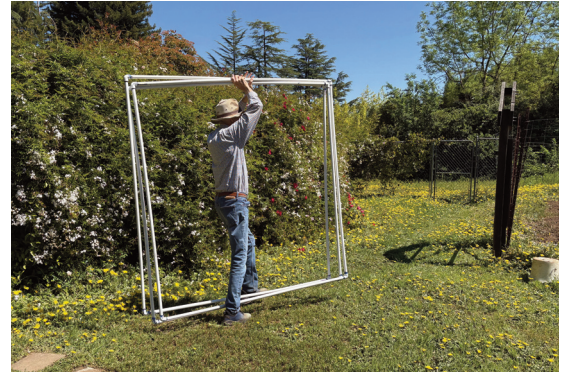
